Installation and QuickStart—Windows Download

If you purchased Chorducopia as a download, you'll be directed to the download area on the Tanager AudioWorks webstore. (Your serial number should have arrived in a separate EMAIL.) Click on the link provided to download the installer to your computer. Chorducopia contains almost 6000 high quality recordings of chord sounds, which makes the program quite large—around 350Mb, similar to a sample library application. Depending on your connection, the download might take some time. And—the overall installation process could take up to 45 minutes including the file downloads—please allot sufficient time to complete this process! Let's get started....



Installing Chorducopia on the Mac

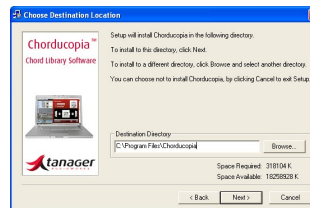

Find the file you downloaded—it is called Chorducopia_Webinstall_Win.zip. Double click on this file. Chorducopia_Webinstall_win should extract—double click this to begin the installation process. Several introduction screens come up—after the license is shown you will see the name/serial number entry screen.



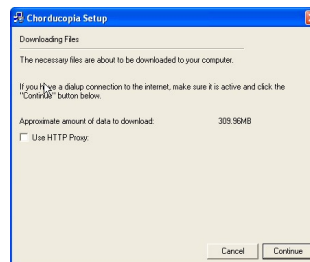

Choose the directory where you would like to install the software, or just accept the default shown.

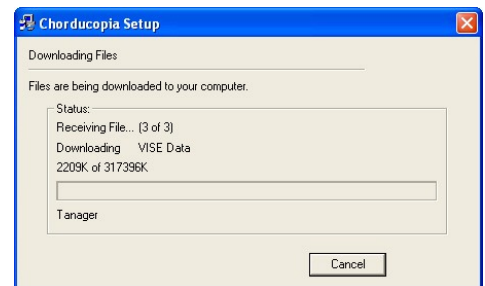
You are now ready to begin the download. Click Continue.

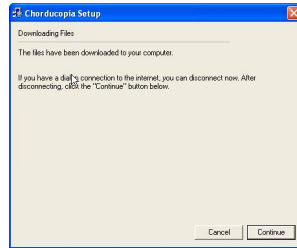

The installer will download the application. Again—be patient, the total size of the files downloaded are around 350MB—do not attempt this unless you have a high speed DSL or Cable Modem internet connection!



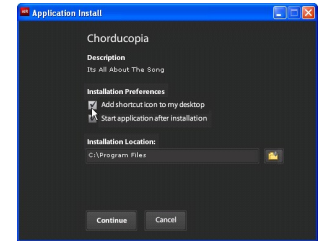

When the file download is completed, the installer will ask for your serial number. Enter it exactly as shown – dashes as well.



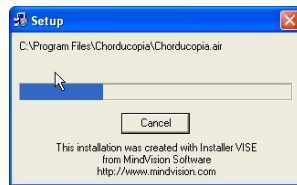

Next, the installer asks where you would like to install Chorducopia. The Applications folder is the default choice. Also- if you don't want to run Chorducopia after the installer finishes, uncheck the box on this screen. Click Continue to proceed.



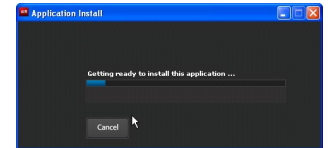

The Chorducopia applications begins to install.

You will see this screen for a few moments while the application installs.

The installer checks your PC to see if the Adobe AIR application is already installed. If it is, click Close and continue. If it is not, Adobe AIR will install on your computer. This only takes a moment.



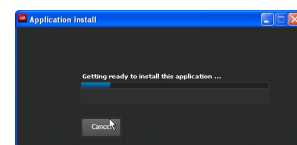

You are finished! Chorducopia runs. Click on the chord diagram and you should hear a C Major chord sound with the "Clean Strat" sound. There is no additional setup required.

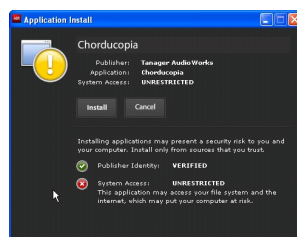
You will see this screen for a while—Adobe AIR does a scan of your computer before it starts the Chorducopia installation. (Note for some Vista Users—you may see two copies of this screen—don't cancel anything! Just let them both continue.)

Chorducopia QuickStart Guide

Chorducopia loads in Grid Mode. Type any chord name or partial chord name in the Search box and hit the **Enter** key - the table below shows the resulting chords. Click on the guitar fretboard diagram to hear the chord played.

Choose from 6 instruments in the **Played On** menu:

- Bank A: actual fretboard diagram voicings shown (3 instruments)
- Bank B: chord formula voicings (3 instruments)

There are 3 Filters for chords provided:

- **All** - Shows all chords in the (990 chords.)
- **Common** - Shows the 21 most commonly found chord types in popular music.
- **Key** - shows a collection of chords representing the chords in the selected Major key as well as some additional related chords.

Once a chord has been selected, click **Show Related** to enter Carousel Mode. This shows 10 chords which share notes in common with the selected chord. Choose how many notes shared in the **Notes** dialog. The number of related chords is displayed at the bottom, and use the right and left arrows to show the next or previous set of 10 related chords. Click on any chord diagram in the carousel to hear the chord sound. Click on the original chord in the upper right to hear it as well - compare chord sounds this way. Click **Back to Results** to return to Grid Mode. Click the Chorducopia name to see the **Help** links, and click it again to return to the main display.
