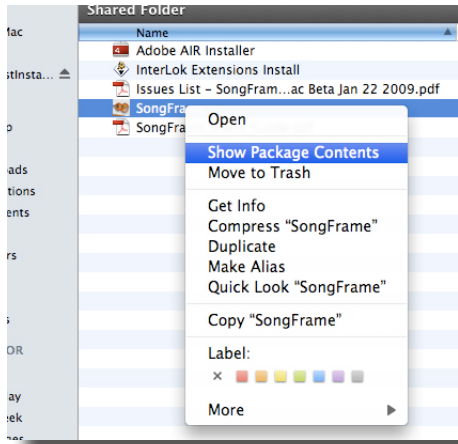


Deleting the Settings File in the SongFrame Mac OS X Version

Finding and deleting the SongFrameSettings.xml file in the Mac version of the program requires a few simple steps as shown below. (Deleting this file often solves many issues related to not being able to see drop down menus in the MIDI and Audio Setup windows after first installing.)

First - open Finder and point to the **SongFrame** application (under the **Applications** folder.) Right click and choose **Show Package Contents**.



Next, expand the **Resources** folder and right click on the application called **SongFrame**.

Choose **Show Package Contents**, and again, open the **Resources** folder and then right click and choose **Show Package Contents** on the Application called **SongFrame**.

Once more, right click, choose **Show Package Contents** and then expand the **Resources** folder. Scroll down until you see a folder called **Settings**, then delete the only file inside that folder called **SongFrame Settings.xml**.

Re-launch SongFrame.
