

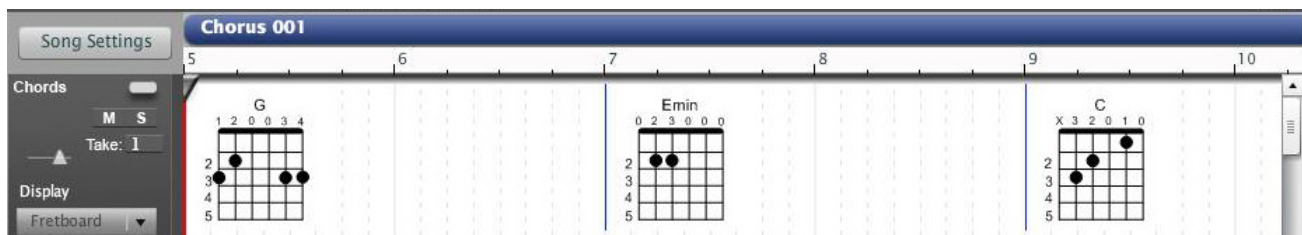
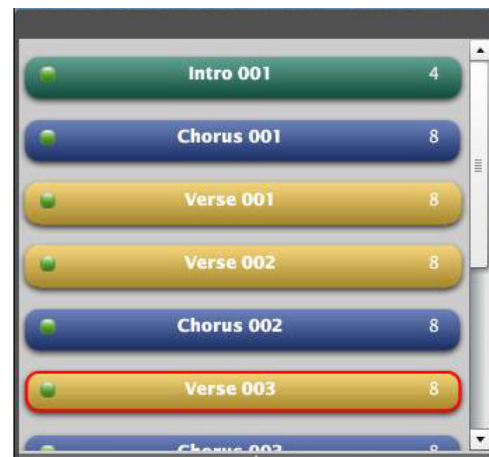
What's New in SongFrame Build 9.0

SongFrame Build 9.0 is now available. Here is a summary of the main additions and enhancements.

- We've eliminated the frustrating challenge/response authorization step we used in all previous versions of SongFrame. This was by far the biggest complaint our customers had. We've replaced it with a new built-in simpler licensing scheme. You will need a new license key to replace your old serial number if you are an existing SongFrame user, but this new license key should work for all future updates of SongFrame. - We now allow chord placement on 8th notes instead of just quarter note beats. You'll see 8th note guides on the track display now in 4/4 time.
- We now allow users to put their own favorite online rhyming dictionary in the Rhymes tool under the Lyrics menu. Many users have a favorite online rhyming dictionary, and now you can specify your own favorite in the Setup - > Global Settings menu. We still default to the RhymeZone site, but you can change this anytime.
- We replaced the "double-click" to expand a SongBit with a green expand and yellow restore button in the upper left of each SongBit. Now, it is easier to right-click an open or closed SongBit to see the context sensitive menus.
- We've added a easier SongBit Length data entry box in the upper right of an expanded SongBit. Now it's easier to see where you control the number of measures in a SongBit.
- We've fixed a number of bugs related to the GUI when SongBits were shortened.
- We've improved the important Export function to ensure all 4/4 songs export properly.
